FUND AIM

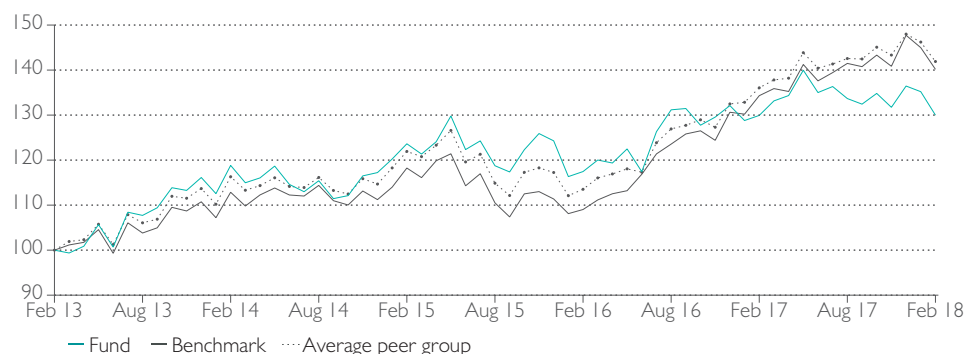
The investment objective of the Fund is to achieve long term capital growth and income through diversified investment in UK equities.

COMMENTARY

The Fund fell by 3.9% over the month compared to a fall of 3.3% in the market. There were two main detractors from relative performance: Sophos and Moneysupermarket. Sophos has been a very strong performer and their results released this month were more cautious on the growth outlook which caused many investors concern. We continue to think that there is a large addressable market and continue to hold the shares. Moneysupermarket has also been weak largely due to fears around growth and the cost of improving their platform. We continue to hold the shares.

We have added a new holding in the portfolio in Beazley and we are most excited about their Cyber division. Since 2009 the Cyber book has grown at a fast pace to become a substantial part of their revenues. They have a dominant market position in US Cyber insurance coverage for the small and mid-capitalized market. There is also the opportunity to grow this offering geographically. The introduction of the General Data and Protection Regulation (GDPR) in May 2018 in Europe could well be a further catalyst for growth. Meanwhile the core business has emerged well from challenging conditions in the wider market with a combined ratio lower than the overall Lloyds market and a very well respected management team. We are positive about the prospects for the company. To fund this purchase we sold the position in Persimmon which has performed well of late and also reduce the holding in CRH. Finally we have sold out holding in Greene King which has had a troubled time. We think this is a quality business but the outlook for casual dining is very challenging and we think there are more interesting ideas elsewhere.
